


### 2: Castle Howard

This great English treasure house is also a wonderland for kids, with loads to see and do including a Bird Garden, penguins, Adventure Playground and dress-up fun.



### 1: Jorvik Viking Centre


Travel back in time via this wonderful reconstruction of York as it would have looked over 1000 years ago.

York's yummiest visitor attraction focuses on the city's 150 year confectionery history and the people who made it all happen.



### 2: The Hepworth Wakefield


Inspiring gallery featuring a unique collection of sculptures by Barbara Hepworth and changing exhibitions by contemporary artists.
